The Verdin Company designed and fabricated the world's only mobile foundry so that a bell can be cast on your site in full view of the public.

The two day can event include marching bands, color guards, and lots of participation from a festive public.









Day 1 of the Bell Casting

The Ingot Brigade

The audience assists the Verdin team in creating a bell by passing the bronze ingots to the furnace.

















500 pounds of bronze ingots are put into the furnace which is heated to 2,200 degrees.

The Bell Pour

The Verdin team suits up as the furnace reaches 2,200 degrees. Casting bells outside in front of hundreds of people had never been done before.

It's a once in a lifetime event!















Once the furnace reaches 2,200 degrees, the molten bronze is poured into a custom bell mold, made especially for a customer, where it will cool and harden overnight. The bell must be cast in one continuous pour.



Day 2 of the Bell Casting

Breaking the Mold

The mold is broken by selected audience participants using a large bronze sledge hammer, thus exposing the custom cast bronze bell.









The Verdin team completes the job with a jackhammer revealing the new bell.









Polishing the Bell

The bell is sandblasted to clean and smooth the surface. It takes about 4 hours to polish the bell and prepare it for presentation.



BELL FACTS

- The furnace can turn 500 pounds of metal into molten liquid in two to three hours.
- Each bell needs at least 12 bronze ingots and each ingot weights about 40 pounds.
- The custom-made mold is contained in a box called a flask.
- The flask is made of steel and weighs more than 500 lbs.
- Each bell weighs 250 pounds and is about two feet tall.
- The bell will sound the musical note "E".
- Bronze metal is a combination of 80% copper and 20% tin.
